Appointment and receipt books, 1946-1949.

BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE: Isabel Cohen graduated in 1924 from the Columbia University School of Dental and Oral Surgery (later the College of Dental Medicine). She practiced until 1980 in New York City, first in the Bushwick section of Brooklyn and then on Myrtle Ave. in the Ridgewood neighborhood of Queens.

SCOPE AND CONTENT: Two appointment books, 1948-1949, and a receipt book, 1946-1947, documenting the dental practice of Isabel Cohen, located during this period in the Ridgewood section of Queens. The appointment books are Fawcett's National Dental Appointment Books, published by J.C. and A.L. Fawcett, Inc., of Brooklyn, N.Y. Though the pre-printed pages include space for information on operations and the teeth worked upon, Cohen only listed the name of the patient and the fee charged. The receipt book records payments relating both to her professional and personal life.
